

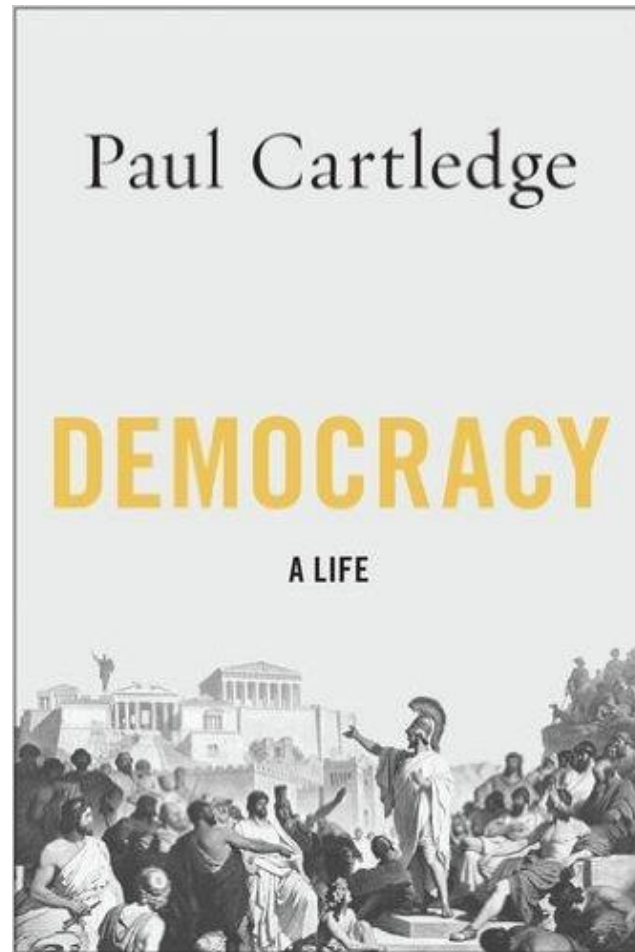

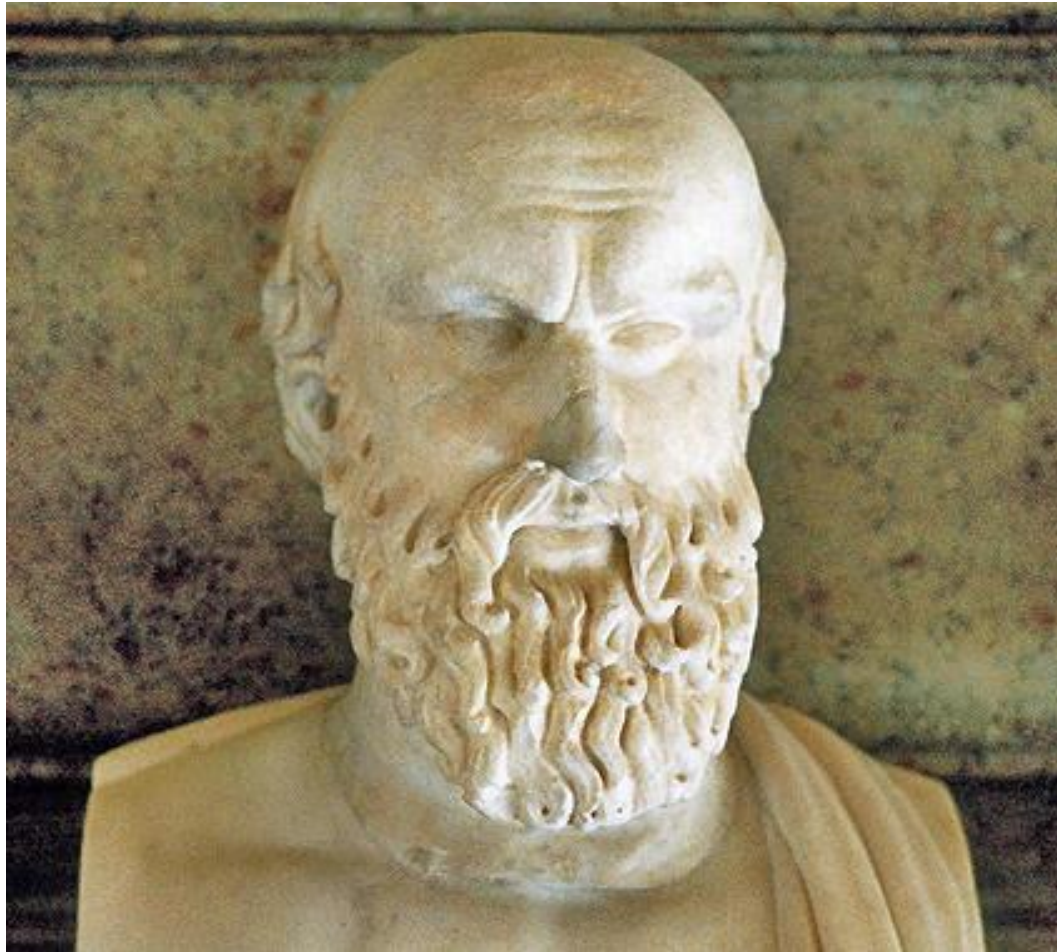

# Language of politics

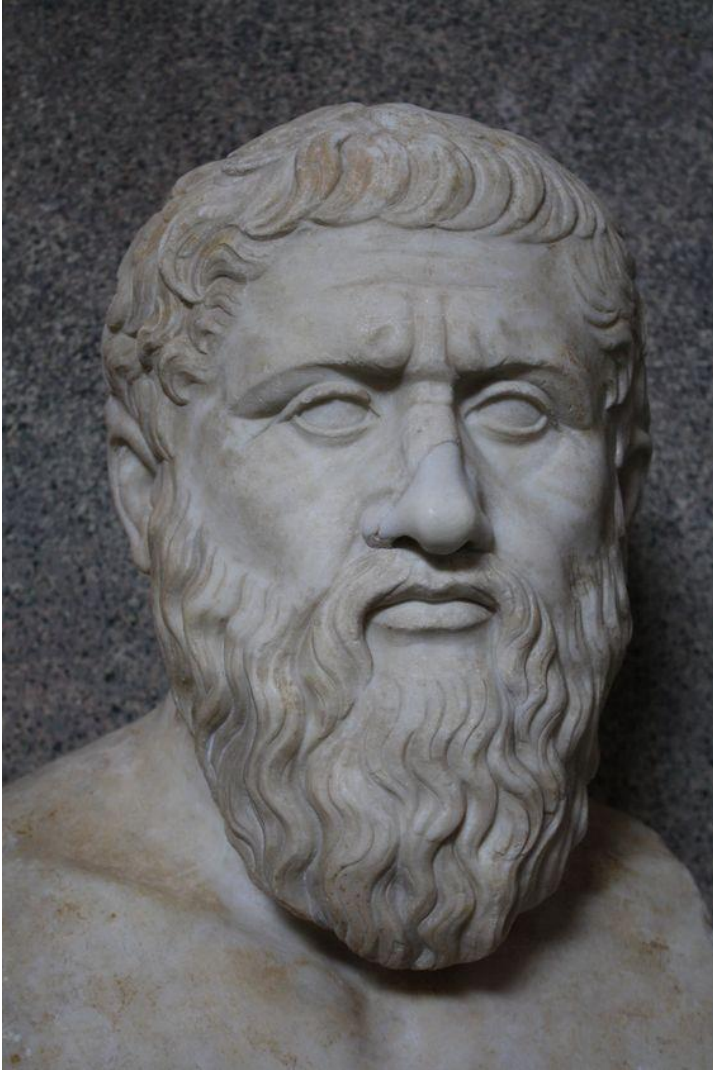
- From **Greek**: politics (from *polis*), anarchy , aristocracy, monarchy, tyranny, oligarchy, plutocracy, ... democracy

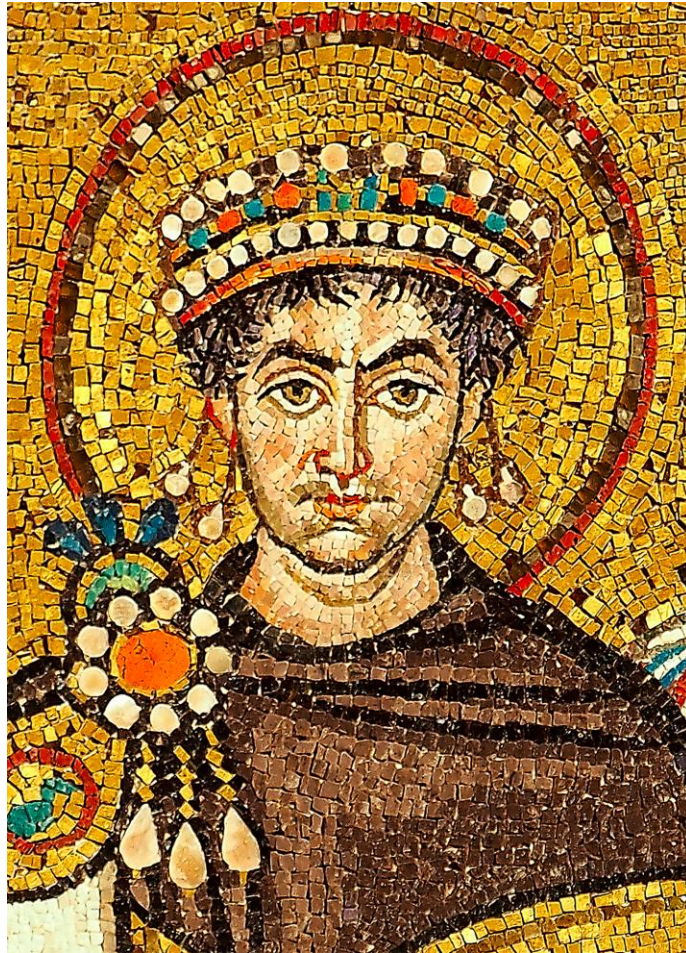
